Following are the Terms and Conditions of Philmont Applicants:

- Must be a Scout, Venturer, or Scouter registered in the Mississippi Valley Council, BSA, and must be 14 years of age by January 1st of the year attending OR have completed the eight grade and be at least 13 years of age prior to attending Philmont. Philmont will make no exceptions. (Age 15 is strongly recommended.)
- Applicants must have the proper attitude and physical strength to withstand the rigors of a rugged trip of this kind. **They MUST have their parents' approval, recommendation of their leader and the final approval of their Philmont Crew Advisor.** All participants, both youth and adults must meet the Height and Weight requirements.
- The committee reserves the right to ask a participant to delay the trip until another year if he or she is, in their opinion, is unable to meet the above physical or age qualifications.
- Attend and participate in "youth/parent" orientation meetings.
- **Participate in all Philmont training weekends and other shakedown weekends as scheduled by the expedition leaders.**
- Cancellation refunds, providing someone takes your place, will be made after the expedition is over.
- Every crew is required to have at least one adult, preferably two, currently certified in American Red Cross Wilderness First Aid or equivalent 16-hour first aid course that includes adult CPR. This is for the crew's protection when they are in remote back-country locations where vehicle access is difficult or impossible.

APPLICANT'S AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTANDING:

"I agree to live by the Scout Oath and Law, to obey and cooperate with the expedition leaders, to meet my full responsibilities as a member of our contingent, to take such preliminary training as required, and to wear the official uniform."

"I understand that I must be physically prepared for the rugged expedition and will participate in the regularly scheduled 'shakedown sessions.' I also understand that I may be dropped from the expedition for unsatisfactory participation in training activities or for inadequate physical condition (see the "Physical Preparation for Philmont Trek" sheet)."

Limitations

NOTE: Youth on the waiting list who have never attended Philmont have priority over youth who may have previously attended Philmont and adults who are not parents of an attending youth, regardless of the date of the application. The exception to this rule is an adult (with his or her child) who may be moved to the contingent active list to satisfy a crew need for in-depth adult leadership regardless of his or her application date. See the complete waiting list policy on the council's website.

Refund Policy

- Canceled before September 15, 2017. We will refund all paid fees less \$125 Council Contingent Reservation fee.
- Canceled after September 15, 2017 and before February 1, 2018, We will refund paid fees less the \$420 paid to Philmont and the \$125 Council Contingent Reservation fee.
- **Canceled after February 1, 2018. No refunds will be made unless your spot can be filled from the council waiting list.** (If someone from the waiting list fills your spot, all fees less \$125 will be refunded.)

Fees

- Actual cost of a Philmont Trek is \$940.00 for 2018.
- A total of \$520 (**which includes the \$100 reservation fee**) must be deposited in the office before September 1, 2017.
- Estimated cost of travel (transportation/meals/equipment/etc.) to and from Philmont is \$475.00-\$570.00
- **Estimated total cost is \$1,600.00.**
- \$125 deposit is required with application (this is subtracted from your total fee).
- Payments will be made in installments – to be determined.
